Tuition Assistance

Santa Clarita Christian School is pleased to serve our community by providing a Biblically based education. We understand that providing a Christian education for our children can present financial challenges. Our school desires to provide assistance to families in need. One such attempt is to allow for significant multiple child discounts. In addition, the board of directors designates a selected portion of the budget for tuition assistance.

In order to maximize these designated assistance funds, we ask that all families interested in seeking assistance begin by researching various funding sources available to them prior to completing an application with the school for assistance. Such sources often include parents, grandparents, churches, etc. Investigations into these funding sources often allow us to spread our assistance across a greater number of families in our school community.

Once interested parties have investigated their available resources, they are welcome to apply for tuition assistance from the school. We will be using the Smart Tuition Aid Analysis program as a professional resource for evaluating the financial needs of interested families. Applications may be submitted online by visiting the Smart Tuition website at www.smarttuitionaid.com. At the website, click on the “New Parent Registration” to begin your application. You will be asked to enter an email and to create a password. Click on “Start New Application” and then enter the school I.D. of 10850. Please follow the instructions on the screen to complete the application. The Smart Tuition Aid Analysis program is completely confidential and is a necessary step that allows SCCS to make the best decision regarding any potential financial aid.

There are a limited number of hard copy applications that may be picked up from the business office by those who do not wish to enroll online. The response time does tend to be longer for paper applications.

Once all of the information has been submitted to Smart Tuition, along with a nominal application fee, Smart Tuition will process your request. All information is kept confidential. Smart Tuition will then generate a report that is given to the school administrator with its professional conclusions based upon the data they receive from the applicant.

Applications for assistance may be submitted to Smart Tuition beginning at open enrollment, which normally takes place in February. The applicant will be notified of the decision normally after the budget for the next school year is approved by the school board (usually in April). Applications for assistance will be received until the funds allocated for such purpose have been awarded. This may vary depending upon the number of applicants and time of year requests have been received. Applicants are encouraged to submit their requests as soon as possible to maximize their chance of receiving funding.

The school gives priority when awarding funding to those current families that have demonstrated a commitment to Santa Clarita Christian School.
