**A. To qualify for CSF membership this semester, follow these guidelines:**

1. You must earn a *minimum of 10 points* from last semester's grades.
  - a. The first 4 points must be from LIST I (unless you are a senior applying for membership in February).
  - b. The first 7 points (including the four points described in a) must be from LISTS I and II.
  - c. The remaining points may come from any LIST (I, II or III).
2. You must use **no more than 5 courses** to qualify.
3. No CSF points are given for physical education, courses taken in lieu of physical education, subjects repeated to improve a grade, courses involving clerking and office/teaching assisting, and courses taken on a pass/fail basis.
4. CSF points are granted as follows:
  - a grade of A = 3 CSF points. (Note: a grade of A in an AP, IB, or Honors course earns 4 CSF points, maximum 2 per semester)
  - a grade of B = 1 CSF point. (Note: a grade of B in an AP, IB, or Honors course earns 2 CSF points maximum 2 per semester)
  - a grade of C = 0 CSF points.
  - a grade of D or F in *any course*, even in one you cannot use to qualify, disqualifies you from membership at this time.
5. One additional point shall be granted for a grade of A or B in an AP, IB, or Honors course, up to a maximum of two such points per semester.

**B. Also remember:**

1. Semester membership is based on work done in the *previous* semester. All courses must be taken at SCCS (Under very limited circumstances summer school may also be used; you should check with your adviser before listing any summer school work.)
2. You must reapply *each* semester.
3. Courses you may use are listed on the reverse side.. They are divided into LISTS I, II, and III.

# CSF Membership Prerequisites

## Santa Clarita Christian School – Chapter 1213sc

The California Scholarship Federation requires that a student earn 10 points in the previous semester to become a member. The regulations are as follows:

1. An "A" grade is equal to 3 points and a "B" grade is equal to 1 point. However, Advanced Placement (AP) and Honors (H) classes receive an extra point for A and B grades. So they would get 4 points for an A, and 2 points for a B (maximum of 2 points per semester total of AP or Honors classes) .
2. You must earn a *minimum of 10 points* from last semester's grades.
  - a.) The first 4 points must be from **List I** (unless you are a senior applying for membership in February or June).
  - b.) The first 7 points (including the 4 points described in section "a") must be from **Lists I and II**.
  - c.) The remaining points may come from any **List (I, II, or III)**. PE courses, subjects repeated to improve a grade, and office/teacher assisting will not be given any CSF points.
3. A minimum of three subjects from **List I and II** must be taken to qualify. Two of these subjects **MUST** be from **List I**, and **ONE** subject may be from **List II**. Seniors in February-June semesters may use three courses from **List II** to qualify.
4. Only 5 classes can be used to acquire the necessary 10 points.
5. A "D" or "F" grade in any subject **DISQUALIFIES A STUDENT** from CSF for that semester.
6. A student who received a poor evaluation in citizenship (cheating, cutting, tardies, etc.) may be precluded from semester membership. This action may affect Life Membership.
